

TSBCP2UP instructions

Fixture controller with sensor ready


MARNING: May result in serious injury or death. Turn off power at circuit breaker before installing the unit.


FEATURES

- 1. Please call a licensed electrician for installation.
- 2. Drill 1/2" KO in the sheet metal for TSBCP2UP installation, make sure the TSBCP2UP well fixed in the luminaire.
- 3. Screw in the sensor into the receptacle and make sure the connection is tight. Ensure the rubber gasket touches the outside surface of the fixture.
- 4. Attach the lens to sensor and turn the lens module clockwise to ensure it locks in place.
- 5. Please refer below diagram for Wiring.
- 6. Return power back to source.
- 7. Commissioned the sensor via Technilight Smart App.

HOW TO ADD

- 1. Press and hold the Reset button for three seconds, then release the Reset button.
- 2. Add TSBCP2UP to the switch page on the app.



IMPORTANT for Figure 1

IF YOU ARE GOING TO USE 1 PIR MOTION SENSOR(MODEL #TSSPESD) TO CONTROL MULTIPLE FIXTURES (POWER PACKS), AFTER FINISHING THE WIRING BETWEEN POWER PACK AND FIXTURE, CONNECT THE POWER PACK'S BROWN WIRE TO POWER PACK'S PINK WIRE. OTHERWISE THE PIR MOTION SENSOR (MODEL #TSSPE5D) WILL NOT WORK NORMALLY.

For Model TSBCP2UP-Dual Channel, it has an extra Orange wire which should connect to the CCT wire to the driver if the driver is color tunable.

TIPS: This Bluetooth device is compatible with Technilight Smart lighting control system only.
